

Summer Arts & Media Camp Financial Aid Program

What Is It?

Columbia College Chicago's Summer Arts & Media Camp financial aid program is a need-based tuition remission program designed for students of all ages who require financial assistance to enroll in the Summer Arts & Media Camp. Our financial aid program provides a discounted rate for campers in need. It is not a loan, nor is it a scholarship with an associated cash value.

Who can apply?

Any child between 6 & 15 years of age may apply for financial aid for the Summer Arts & Media Camp.

How Much Aid Will I Receive?

Your financial aid award is determined by a number of factors including income level, number of dependents in the household, special circumstances such as health issues or job loss, and other factors. We cannot tell you exactly how much aid you will receive until after your application has been reviewed by the financial aid committee.

However, we can tell you that generally speaking, award amounts range from a 10% - 50% discount, depending on student need and overall demand for the program.

Do I Earn Too Much To Receive Financial Aid?

We do not base financial aid decisions solely on your reported yearly income. We understand that some families have unique circumstances that may not be clearly reflected on your tax return such as small business owners and freelancers, additional adult dependents, etc. If you truly feel that the tuition for the Summer Arts & Media Camp presents a barrier to your child's participation, we strongly encourage you to apply for financial aid, regardless of how much you may or may not earn.

How Do I Apply?

Applicants must provide us with three things:

- 1) A completed Financial Aid Application Form (available for download from our website).
- 2) A copy of your most recent federal tax return.
- 3) A \$20.00 application fee.
